“Another reason for the great unpopularity of Christians was that most people believed them to be guilty of all kinds of evil practices...Some of these accusations arose through a misunderstanding of genuine Christian practices. The accusation of cannibalism, for example, was probably based on the Lord’s supper, where Christians spoke of eating Christ’s flesh and drinking His blood; the accusation of incest arose partly from the fact that Christians called each other ‘brother’ and ‘sister’ and ‘loved each other’.”

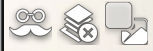


LET'S READ

Jesus in John 14:15-18

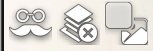
